Dear Parent/Guardian

Following a review of our Behaviour for Learning Policy, we have decided to make some changes to the way that we deal with disruptive behaviour in school. Whole school detentions have been introduced to punish persistent disruptive behaviour in the classroom.

Behaviour in the classroom is managed through a consequence system with C1 and C2 being used as warnings that a student's behaviour is unacceptable. The vast majority of students will never receive a consequence and, if they do, they will settle down to learning and cause no more disruption.

However, if a C3 is issued, this will result in a 30 minute after school detention the next day. A C4 incident will result in a 60 minute after school detention the next day. If an after school detention is issued, your child will be given a detention card which they must take home and show to you. A text message will also be sent to your mobile phone. So if you have a new number can you please let the school know.

Failure to complete a detention or failing the rules of detention will result in extended time in our isolation room.

Continued defiance and non compliance could result in short term fixed exclusion.
