Corona Virus Update 17: 1st June 2020

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you have had a lovely weekend and taken some time to enjoy what is now late Spring.

Now it will be about managing expectations – of parents, of the media, of ourselves. Because it's not going to be business as usual for any school any time soon. Instead, it will be about a cautious, phased reopening for some pupils, with some staff, for some activities - when the time is right.

Before we begin to start thinking about opening for more students, we will need to carry out a range of risk assessments, school building adaptations and specific plans - all of which are currently being worked on.

Below is a list of the key actions we are taking to support and satisfy latest guidance.

- From 1st June, Y10 calls will be made by Team Leaders (Tutors) to see how each student is doing. Staff will ask a few questions and see if there are any specific issues that need picking up and arrange any follow-up support.
- From 15th June, Subject teachers will conduct follow-up calls to Y10 students that have requested specific support.
- In addition to the above, all other year groups will be supplied online work in the usual fashion.

I urge parents/carers to keep encouraging their children to complete this work. Please note that attitude to learning grades are being logged - this is particularly important for those Y10 students that are not engaging. These are used towards GCSE predictions.

Now we are back into a new term, I will of course keep you regularly updated on school developments.
