Additional message from Mo Bunter (Deputy Principal)

As a College, Greenhead have received an unprecedented number of concerned emails from Year 11s across the region with regards to how they can continue their preparations for progression to Greenhead College. I have listed below suggestions and an answer to an incorrect rumour that is going around at the minute, which would be good if you could share with your students:

- 1. Greenhead College WILL NOT be using admissions tests or any other test, as a result of the GCSE examinations being cancelled this summer.*
- 2. We recommend that where you are progressing to subjects at A Level that you have studied for the GCSE exams, you review the theory and concepts that you have covered and where you have mark schemes you could practise exam questions, to keep your subject knowledge and exam technique up to date.*
- 3. Where you will be studying a new subject we will be uploading on to the College website some preparation work that you can do prior to starting at the College for each of the subjects that we offer. This will be in place in time for the start of the summer term and we will put a message on the website to let prospective students know that the work is ready for them.*
- 4. Please be reassured that we understand how stressful this is for all of you, and our curriculum and pastoral teams are adapting their induction processes to ensure that we put additional support in place taking into account this unprecedented situation. This will help you to adapt to studying at the next level, taking into account that you have not been in school since March 2020.*

The team at Greenhead College will do everything within our control to prepare all of our incoming Year 12 students effectively for their next steps.
