We have been asked by Huddersfield Town Football Club to help their first team squad to learn some basic BSL signs as part of the upcoming Sign Language Week. This is an exciting opportunity and your child has been chosen to participate.

The trip will take place on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March and we will be travelling to PPG Canalside by school minibus. Students will have an early lunch in school and leave school at approximately 12:30 pm, we will expect to be back in school at around 2:30pm in time to travel home by taxi as usual.

Huddersfield Town will be filming the students as they teach the players. The footage will be used as a promotional tool to raise awareness of BSL in Sign Language Week (18<sup>th</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup> March) via the Club's and the Foundation's communication channels. The students will meet first team players and help teach them basic football related signs and to sign their own name.

There will be an opportunity for the students to get something signed by the players who they have been with after the filming. The club will provide a match day programme for each student to get signed as a thank you.
