I would like to apologise for any inconvenience caused by the postponement of Noel Williams' visit. We have fortunately rescheduled for the 16th July 2018.

Noel is a young man who has been through the Criminal Justice System (CJS), spent time in gangs, witnessed serious crime and spent time in custody. He is now studying Social Sciences – Sociology, politics and governmental studies at University of Bedfordshire in Luton. He works as a freelance consultant offering techniques and strategies to help professionals and parents deal with young people who are affiliated with gangs.

Noel is heavily involved with a number of boards and committees including Peer Power Board, Youth Safety Action Board, as well as being on the standing committee for the Youth Justice Board and the Parliamentary Commission on Youth Justice. Noel is evidently at the heart of shaping effective change within the CJS and we look forward to his rearranged visit.

The event will cover his story on how he successfully exited a life of crime, specific techniques and strategies to support young people and a Q and A session. He will speak with individual Year Groups throughout the day before finishing with a presentation to parents from 2pm whilst 3pm. We have been fortunate enough to witness Noel in action earlier this year when he delivered an informative and inspiring talk to the Youth Offending Team.
