Re-Start A Heart Day Fundraising Day – Friday 12th July 2019

It is estimated that less than 1 in 10 people in the UK survive an out-of-hospital cardiac arrest and this has been partly attributed to two factors that communities can change:

- there aren't enough people prepared to perform CPR when someone has a cardiac arrest
- there aren't enough community defibrillators

By having a defibrillator in our community and by training people in CPR, we can play an important part in saving more lives.

The Newsome Community are currently fundraising to purchase a defibrillator to be placed in the village and being at the heart of the community we would like to play our part in helping raise money for this important piece of equipment. We are therefore holding a 'Re-start a Heart' day on Friday 12th July 2019.

The day will involve various activities available at break time. As we want to raise as much money as we can, we are asking for minimum donations as follows:-
