

SNAP DAY 1 – Friday October 7th

As part of the curriculum at Newsome High School and Sports College, we have four special ‘SNAP’ days when lessons stop and students are engaged in a range of activities which helps us deliver aspects of citizenship, work related learning and health education. The dates for the SNAP days this year are;

- Friday October 7th
- Thursday November 24th
- Wednesday April 5th
- Tuesday June 27th

Details of our 1st Snap day are:

Year 7 – will be doing a range of activities on the theme of safety. They will take part in a personal safety session, learn some first aid skills and complete workshops on fire safety, staying safe on the internet and road awareness. Year 7 students should attend as normal in school uniform.

Year 8 – will be carrying out activities which promote a healthy life style. As a sports college we aim to encourage all students to take part in physical activity and the day introduces a range of possibilities. Students need to come to school in uniform but need their PE kit with them.

Year 9 – The students in year 9 are taking part in a series of activities around the theme of Democracy and how politics works. Students attend in uniform as usual.

Year 10 – students will be following a series of workshops following our Relationships and sexual health education programme. Topics covered include:

- Causes of domestic violence
- Breast and testicular cancer
- Pregnancy
- Parenthood
- Early years feeding

Students attend in uniform as usual.

Year 11 – Most of year 11 will be taking part in a ‘Fit for Work’ conference which is part of our careers programme. The day will take place at Lockwood Park Rugby Club running from 8.45 – 3.00pm. The students should come dressed smartly – as if attending an interview for a job. Lunch is provided for everyone as part of the conference.
