

SNAP Day 4 – Tuesday June 27th

Our last SNAP day of the year is on Tuesday next week – June 27th. SNAP days are held when we stop the usual timetable lessons and replace them with a series of activities which promote some of the personal, social, health and citizenship related aspects of the curriculum. Listed below are the activities which are planned for each year group along with specific instructions.

Year 7

Students in this year group have been offered a trip to Chester Zoo. The group are setting off at 8.15am and hope to return to school by 5pm. This is a non uniform trip – students should come in sensible clothing for an outdoor visit, bring a coat and a packed lunch + drinks.

Any student who is not attending the trip should attend school as usual, in uniform but have their PE kit with them. Some have been set up to do some work with our Bikeability training team during the day.

Year 8

Students in this year group should attend school as usual in uniform. They will be undertaking a series of activities to promote international awareness. The activities have been put in place by the Modern Foreign Languages team. Normal school timings apply.

Year 9

Students in this year group should attend school as usual in uniform. They will be doing activities around a crystal maze challenge which focuses on literacy and numeracy skills. Normal school timings apply.

Year 10

There are two humanities trips going running on Tuesday as follows;

1. A History trip to the Thackray Medical Museum to support the work on medicine through time – one of the GCSE History topics. The group are meeting at 9.00am following registration and aim to be back on site by 3.00pm. This is a uniform trip – students also need a packed lunch, drinks and writing equipment.
2. A Geography field trip to Hornsea to complete field work which is part of the GCSE coursework component. The group are meeting at school at 7.50am – estimated return time is 5.15pm. This is a non uniform trip – sensible clothes and a coat are required along with a packed lunch.

Any year 10 student who is not attending a field trip should attend school as usual, in uniform. They will be supporting the year 8 international activities.
