Your son/daughter has been invited to participate in the Newsome High school Science and Technology week that will be taking place on 21st, 22nd and 23th of March 2018.

The events will take place after school and be spread over three evenings from 3.00pm – 4.15pm. The evenings will give them an enjoyable insight into STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) as a possible career path in the future and give them experience of science that they would not normally come across in a “normal” science lesson.

Activities will include:
