As we come towards the end of the academic year, we would like to reiterate the uniform standards at Newsome High School in order to maintain high expectations.

It is a non negotiable that **all students** are to be in **full uniform** at **all times** during the school day. In order to clarify, please see the images at the bottom of the letter.

As of Monday 17th June, sanctions will be in place and issued to those students who do not follow the uniform policy and expectations.

If a student is not wearing full school uniform and does not have a written note in their passport from a parent/carer explaining the reason why they are not in correct uniform, they will receive a detention.

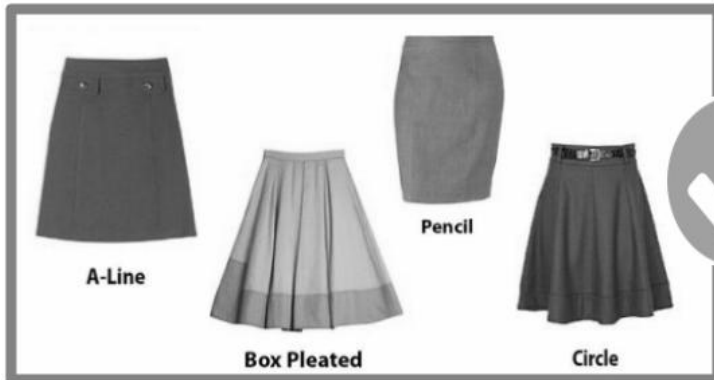
Students will be informed of this on their arrival to school and it will be their responsibility to attend the detention. Failure to attend will result in further sanctions.

We are fully aware that students may outgrow uniform, however the expectation of all students to meet uniform standards remains consistent for the whole school year and adheres to our core values.

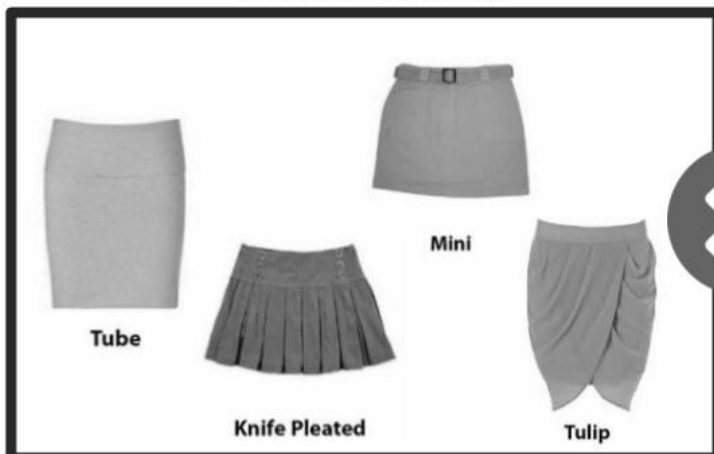

All skirts must be **BLACK** and **KNEE-LENGTH** and worn with **BLACK TIGHTS**.



Skirt Guidance

Skirts need to be sensible, modest and respectable.

Black, knee-length and non-stretchy material should be worn at all times.



Trousers must be black, loose or slim fitting.

Trouser Guidance

Trousers need to be black, sensible, modest and respectable in a loose or slim-fit style.



Skinny trousers/jeans or leggings/jeggings are not acceptable.



Footwear must be black, plain leather shoes that can be polished.

Shoe Guidance

In the interests of safety, all pupils are expected to wear sensible footwear on the school premises.



Black leather, low heeled (no more than 1 inch high), lace-up or slip-on shoes with strap and enclosed heels and toes. All laces must be black. There must be no visible logos or labels.
